The first is the University of New Mexico's Fall 2016 Commencement Program. The Undergraduate Commencement will take place on Friday, December 16, at 6:00 p.m. in the WisePies Arena (better known to you as "The Pit"). The Graduate Commencement will take place on Thursday, December 15, at 6:00 p.m. in WisePies Arena. UNM President Robert Frank will preside over both ceremonies, which I expect to be well-attended by faculty, staff, and students, all of whom will be in academic regalia (i.e., cap and gown). At this event, the President will officially confer your degree upon you. The second event is the School of Engineering Fall 2016 Convocation. This will take place on Saturday, December 17, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. in Ballrooms A/B/C inside the Albuquerque Convention Center downtown (West convention center, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor). The Convocation is the School's own ceremony specifically to honor you, in the presence of your family and friends. The highlight of this event is the recognition of each SOE graduate individually on stage, where you will be congratulated by your department faculty and staff, your deans, and the Convocation's honored guests. Graduate students will be met on the stage by their faculty thesis/dissertation advisor for the traditional "hooding" ceremony.

If you plan to attend the SOE Convocation, please report to ballrooms A/B/C in the Albuquerque Convention Center **between 9:15 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.** in order to receive your data information card and line up for the procession.

Cap and gown is the appropriate dress for graduates. "Civilian" dress is also acceptable. Caps and gowns can be obtained from the UNM Bookstore. If you wish to send formal announcements to your family and friends, you can purchase them at the bookstore as well.
